Mountain Trail Class Descriptions

<u>3 & Under In Hand No cross Entry</u> – For horses 3 years of age and younger. NO cross entry into ridden classes.

Open In Hand – Open to all ages and skill levels of riders and horses.

<u>Saddle Type/English Type Horse Ridden</u> – Open to English type horses only. No cross entry into Western type horse.

<u>Stock Type/Western Type Horse Ridden – Open to stock type horses only. No cross entry into English</u> horse.

Youth- For any youth riders 18 & Under as of January 1st.

Mustang – Open to branded and titled mustangs.

<u>First Timer</u> – Open for all riders who have never competed in a mountain trail competition prior to January 1st 2024

<u>Amateur</u> – Open to all riders who do not and have never received financial compensation for training or lessons. This class is for Non Professional riders.

<u>Select</u> – For riders who as of January 1st 2024 were age 50 and over.

Adult 19-49 – For riders who as of January 1st 2024 were between the ages of 19-49.

<u>Jr. Horse –</u> For all equine 5 years or younger as of January 1st 2024.

<u>Sr. Horse –</u> For all equine 6 years or older as of January 1st 2024.

Open Ridden – Open to all ages and skill levels of riders and horses.
